He made his children Jacob, Ribca, Moses, Aron and Rache, their legal chair and signed all his business activities over to Sara his wife. In earlier notarial deeds he had already given substantial sums of money for the establishment of two Yeshivas in his name, in Hebron, and in Jerusalem respectively.
